THANK YOU

Thank you to all who are faithful in their offerings and support of Good Shepherd in 2023. Your generosity of time, talents, and offerings are greatly needed and very much appreciated! As we march nearer to calling a pastor, contributions to support our church are even more important and necessary.

Note that our financial situation has benefited from the following:

- Pastoral salary spending much lower than budgeted as we are not yet paying for a called pastor.
- \$20,000 in income year-to-date with the leasing of our basement to The Academy School.
- \$2,013 from various groups using our facility so far this year.
- \$20,000 in one-time donations.

Thankfully, we were able to support two major recent expenses: fence replacement at \$18,725.92 and furnace replacement at \$15,792.
