From Deacon Liz

As we move into the liturgical calendar's season of "Ordinary Time," we are entering into an UNordinary place! Good Shepherd is engaging a call process that looks and feels totally new and wonky and, maybe even a little scary. While we wait and pray and listen and wait some more for whatever the Spirit puts in front of us next, I would like to remind you of one piece of ordinary time that we can latch on to. As followers of Jesus, we know that our ordinary time is meant to be spent living the resurrection with Jesus by our side!

What does that mean, you ask? Well, it means that Jesus calls us to live lives without fear. Without trepidation. Without judgement. Rather we are called to live with curiosity, love, and a sense of community and collegiality that bonds us to the meaning of the resurrection! Jesus' resurrection is a daily reminder to us that death does NOT have the final say, and that we are called to live without fear of death, trusting in the promise that God's love knows no bounds, breaks all assumptions, and stays with us as God promised to through thick and thin.

Jesus, being as fully human as he was divine, knew better than to believe that we humans could simply cast away all our fear and live like this though ;-) He understood the draw to be scared and uncertain. And thusly, he left us with the Holy Spirit to guide, comfort, and agitate us toward freedom.

As we enter ordinary time in this extra UN-ordinary moment in the life and timeline of Good Shepherd's ministry, we are encouraged to trust in the resurrection. God will do GOOD and HOLY things with you – whether we know it or want it or understand it or not! What a gift to be able to fully lean in to trusting our God's discernment!

- At this point we have a quote from Cascade Fence for the fence located along the east boundary line. Our neighbors to the east have agreed to join us in paying to replace that fence. As for the fence on the west side of the church, we will be asking for an additional quote from Cascade Fence.
- The disability-access stall in the women's bathroom has been reinstalled and is working normally.
- Thanks to several devoted individuals for continuing to upkeep the grounds, whether it be the gardening, weeding, or the mowing. THANK YOU!!
